O.C.G.A. § 15-18-32 (j)(1) All information regarding a disciplinary or incapacity matter of a prosecuting attorney shall be kept confidential by the Investigative Panel and Commission staff before formal charges are filed and served;

O.C.G.A. § 15-18-32 (k)Notwithstanding subsection (j) of this Code section, information regarding a disciplinary or incapacity matter of a district attorney or solicitor-general may be disclosed or the confidentiality of such information may be removed when: (1) The privilege of confidentiality has been waived by the individual who was the subject of the commission's investigation;

I understand that I have the right to keep the PAQC's actions and findings in matter (if it exists) confidential unless or until formal charges are filed with the Hearing Panel. I also understand that under the current state of the law I can waive this confidentiality. I hereby freely, knowingly, and voluntarily waive confidentiality in this matter, and ask that information regarding this complaint (if it exists) and any actions and or decisions by the Investigative Panel be released to me. I understand that I may or may not further release this information publicly in response to public allegations by the complainant.
